

Getting to Dundee from Aberdeen

The fastest method of public transport to travel from Aberdeen to Dundee is by train with tickets from £11.20, with an average of 22 trains running per-day. Aberdeen's main train station is based in the city centre, 7 miles (11km) from the airport. The nearest train station to the airport is the unmanned Dyce station, located two miles away with tickets available from the ticket vending machine. All southbound trains pass through Aberdeen station where onward connections to Dundee are available by purchasing tickets from the ticket office. You can reach the train stations from the airport by bus or taxi in less than 30 minutes.

For passengers who might need a little extra assistance, Aberdeen Airport provides <u>information</u> and advice to make the journey through the airport as easy and stress-free as possible.

Where do I get a taxi?

Contact Comcab on +44 (0) 1224 353 535. The taxi rank is located outside the front of the terminal. As you leave turn left for the taxi rank where a taxi marshal will assist you.

How long will the journey from Aberdeen airport to Dundee take?

Around 1 hour and 20 minutes

How much will it cost?*

The average fare to Dundee city centre from Aberdeen airport is around £130. Remember to take advantage of special offers available for airport transfers <u>here</u>.

Train from Aberdeen to Dundee

Where do I get a train?

There are two stations, an unstaffed station in Dyce, located two miles away from the airport, and the main station, situated in the city centre and joined with Union Square shopping mall

When do they run?

Trains run at least once every hour Monday to Saturday and less frequently on Sundays. A full timetable can be viewed here www.trainline.com

How long will the journey from Edinburgh to Dundee take?

Around 1 hour 30 minutes from Dyce and 1 hour 20 minutes from Aberdeen main station

How much will it cost?*

Prices start from £11.20

Where do I get tickets?

Tickets can be purchased on the train from Dyce or from the vending machines located at both Dyce and Aberdeen main stations. Tickets can also be purchased from the ticket office at Aberdeen station

How do I get to the train station?

Bus

Where do I get the bus?

You can get the bus from directly outside the airport terminal which is clearly signposted from the UK Arrivals gate

When do they run?

Buses operate 7 days a week from 04:00 to 24:00 full timetable available at http://www.aberdeenairport.com/transport-and-directions/buses-and-coaches

What bus do I need to get?

Jet Service 727 - this is the express bus service and runs every ten minutes Monday to Friday during daytime service from the airport to Union Square, which is joined to the main Aberdeen train station

The Jet Connect Service 80 - operates Monday to Friday from 06:06 to 18:53 linking Aberdeen airport with Dyce train station

How long will the journey from the airport to the train station take?

The journey from the airport to the main Aberdeen station will take around 30 minutes. Travelling from the airport to Dyce train station will take around 16 minutes

How much will it cost?*

Tickets for the Jet Service 727 cost from £2.80 per passenger and can be purchased from the driver. Tickets for the Jet Connect Service 80 cost £1.70 and can be purchased from the driver

Taxi

Where do I get a taxi?

The taxi rank is located outside the front of the terminal. As you leave turn left for the taxi rank where a taxi marshal will assist you

How long will the journey from Aberdeen airport to the train station take?

Around ten minutes to Dyce train station and 25 minutes to the main station in the city centre

How much will it cost?*

The average fare to Dyce costs £7 and to the city centre from the airport cost around £15

Where can I get more information?

Telephone the official airport taxi operator Comcab on +44 (0) 1224 353 535 or alternatively visit the airport taxi office, located to the right of the main entrance to the terminal

Where to go when you arrive at Dundee?

On arrival at Dundee train station, located near the city centre on Riverside Drive, taxis are available from the main exit of the station for onward journeys
