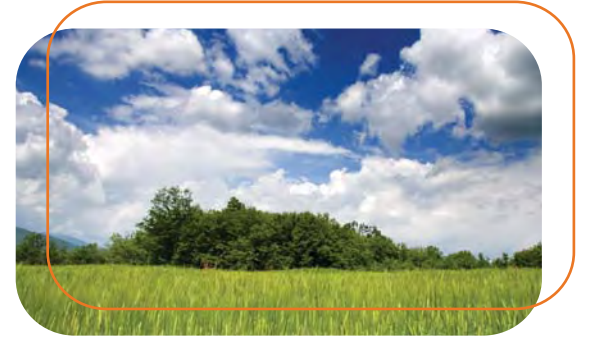

**4.30pm-5.30pm** – Refreshments will be served free of charge in the Marquee.

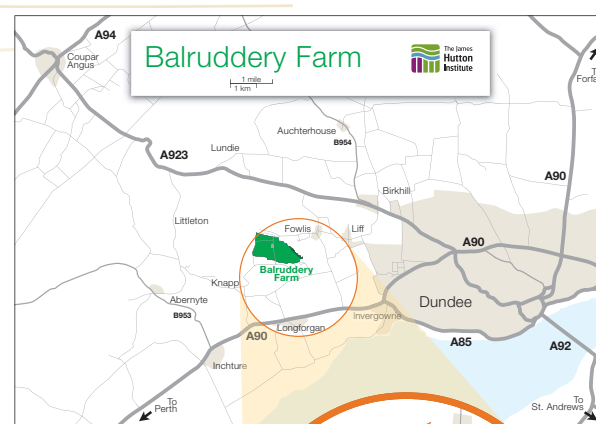

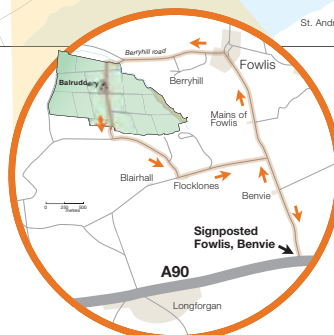
The James Hutton Institute, SAC, SSCR and representatives of the cereals industry will be present in the marquee, showing and explaining their latest research and products.
