



## Getting to Dundee from Glasgow International Airport

The fastest method of public transport to travel from Glasgow International Airport to Dundee is by train with tickets from £6.90 with an average of 26 trains running per-day. Glasgow Queen Street station, located 9 miles (14km) from the airport runs a direct service to Dundee. You can reach the train station from the airport by bus or taxi in less than 30 minutes.

## Taxi direct from Glasgow International Airport to Dundee

### Where do I get a taxi?

The official Glasgow airport taxi rank is located directly in front of the main terminal, and operates 24 hours a day seven days a week. Contact Official Glasgow Airport Taxis on +44 (0) 141 889 1813 for more information

### How long will the journey from Glasgow International airport to Dundee take?

It will take around 1 hour 30 minutes to travel from Glasgow International airport to Dundee city centre

### How much will it cost?\*

## Train from Glasgow International Airport to Dundee

### Where do I get a train?

Glasgow Queen Street station, located in the city centre near George Square runs a direct service to Dundee

Glasgow Queen Street provides a step-free entrance and disability assistance.

### When do they run?

Trains run at least once every hour Monday to Saturday and less frequently on Sundays. A full timetable available can be viewed here [www.thetrainline.com/train-times/glasgow-queen-street-to-dundee/](http://www.thetrainline.com/train-times/glasgow-queen-street-to-dundee/)

### How long will the journey from Glasgow to Dundee take?

Around 1 hour 30 minutes

### How much will it cost?\*

Prices start from £6.90

### Where do I get tickets?

Tickets can be purchased from the vending machines or from the ticket office at Glasgow Queen Street station

### How do I get to the train station?

## Bus

### Where do I get the bus?

You can get the First 500 Glasgow Shuttle bus from Stance 1 which is clearly signposted from the UK Arrivals gate

### When do they run?

The First 500 Glasgow Shuttle bus operates 24 hours a day, 364 days a year. During peak times the service runs every ten minutes, and on off-peak times every 20 minutes. Full time tables can be viewed at [www.firstglasgow.com](http://www.firstglasgow.com)

### What bus do I need to get?

First 500 Glasgow Shuttle - this is the official service running from the airport to Glasgow city centre. The service runs from the airport to Glasgow Queen Street train station

### How long will the journey from the airport to the train station take?

The journey from the airport to Glasgow Queen Street station will take around 21 minutes

### **How much will it cost?\***

Tickets for the First 500 Glasgow Shuttle cost from £6.50 per passenger and can be purchased from the driver

## **Taxi**

### **Where do I get a taxi?**

The official Glasgow airport taxi rank is located directly in front of the main terminal, and operates 24 hours a day seven days a week

### **How long will the journey from Edinburgh airport to the train station take?**

It will take around 15 minutes to get to Glasgow Queen Street station in the city centre

### **How much will it cost?\***

The average fare from the airport to Glasgow city centre cost around £20

### **Where can I get more information?**

### **Where to go when you arrive at Dundee?**

On arrival at Dundee train station, located near the city centre on Riverside Drive, taxis are available from the main exit of the station for onward journeys
