

The James Hutton Institute is one of the world's leading scientific research institutions based in Scotland and at the forefront of transformative science for the sustainable management of land, crop and natural resources.



In 2023/24, for every **£1 funding** the Hutton received from the Scottish Government, it delivered more than **£15 in economic value for the UK economy**, of which **£9** was retained in Scotland.

It contributed:



- **£358.9 million GVA** to the UK economy
 - Of this **£210.7 million GVA** in Scotland
 - Of this: **£61.8 million GVA** in the Aberdeen and Dundee city regions

It supported around **2,575 jobs**:



- Of which **1,525 jobs were in Scotland**
- 740 jobs in the Aberdeen and Dundee city regions

*Gross Value Added (GVA) – a measure of the monetary contribution an organisation adds to the economy through its operations
Employment – measured in terms of headcount jobs supported*
