Independence – the Hutton is independent of industry and government enabling it to have academic freedom to conduct research without political or corporate influence and also nurture scientific integrity.



Collaborative – the Hutton is known for effective collaboration with industry and at the science-policy interface and is effective at sharing information.



Quality - By providing high-quality scientific evidence, it plays a critical role in shaping strategies that improve society, both in Scotland and via its international work.
