Train or coach

A limited number of trains stop at the Invergowrie railway station (12min walk to Hutton), which runs on the Dundee to Glasgow line. Dundee is the closest principal railway station with regular connections along the east coast including Aberdeen (1h15min), Inverness (3h30min), Edinburgh (1h15min), Glasgow Queen Street (1h30min), London Kings Cross (6h), London Euston (overnight) and other UK cities. See [National Rail Enquiries](#). Dundee is also served by coaches. See [Stagecoach](#), [National Express](#) or [Megabus](#).

The Dundee train station is an 1h25min walk, 30min cycle, 40min bus and 15min taxi journey from the Hutton. [Bike&Go](#) is available at Dundee train station.



Local bus

Buses going to Invergowrie are bus number 30 and 31 (don't go to Dundee train station) and 16 (stops at Invergowrie Inn and can be taken from Dundee train station). From the Invergowrie Main Street, walk down Errol road and turn right onto the footpath signposted Invergowrie Walks Network School Loan (11min). From Carse Place, follow the road for 40m and turn right into the Hutton driveway (6min). Whitehall Street is the closest stop to Dundee train station and Seagate (opposite M&S) is the closest stop to the main bus station. See [timetables](#).

By foot

If arriving on foot, the reception can be found in the Crop Innovation Centre, located at the north of the campus and at the top of the new driveway (see map above). It can also be reached on foot by using the old drive off Errol Road, located at the southernmost point of the campus. Please be aware of farm machinery and other vehicles on the roads around the campus. There are accessible paths leading to Invergowrie reception.



Cycling

There is a pleasant, off-road cycling route to Invergowrie from the town centre running parallel to Riverside Drive. This takes about 30mins from the train station. To find our cycle shelters, cycle up the Hutton new driveway and follow signage on campus for bicycle parking.

Car

Please follow signs on campus which will direct you to parking areas. Accessible parking can be found directly outside Reception in our Crop Innovation Centre. The Institute has [two fast charge points](#) for electric vehicles. These are on the ChargeYourCar/ChargePlaceScotland network. To find them, drive up the Hutton's new driveway. At the junction, go left and then take the first right. The chargers are in a parking bay 50m further on your left.



Air travel

There are direct flights to [Dundee Airport](#) from London Heathrow & Sumburgh, Kirkwall with Loganair. The closest international airport is [Edinburgh Airport](#). We encourage you to avoid taking flights where possible.
